Doug Brinson Elected NCAEC President

PANTEGO, NC – J. Douglas Brinson of Arapahoe, vice president of Tideland Electric Membership Corporation's board of directors, was recently elected president of the board of directors for the North Carolina Association of Electric Cooperatives (NCAEC).

Brinson was elected president during the association's annual meeting in Raleigh. The elections took place during the business session of the meeting on April 6. Brinson previously held the position of NCAEC vice president.

NCAEC is a statewide trade association that has worked since 1943 to promote training, safety, education and legislative advocacy on behalf of electric cooperative members. Since 1946, the association has published the award-winning Carolina Country magazine which is mailed monthly to more than 600,000 families, farms and businesses in North Carolina. NCAEC programs serve the needs of their 26 member cooperatives, which are member owned, not-for-profit and overseen by a board of directors elected by the membership.

North Carolina's electric cooperatives serve 2.5 million people in 93 of the state's 100 counties. Tideland EMC serves more than 22,800 accounts in Beaufort, Pamlico, Hyde, Washington, Dare and Craven counties.
